A GROWING NEED

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Every year, River
House members and
their caregivers tell
us how much of a
difference we make in
their lives.

Our services provide relief to caregivers who need time to themselves, so that they can be their best for their loved ones. Each day at River House, essential community socialization and therapeutic recreation helps to slow cognitive decline and keeps aging adults feeling more engaged, happier, and healthier.

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89% of aging adults want to remain in their homes and communities as long as possible.

However, caring for a dependent adult can put a significant strain on caregivers and often causes them to consider alternative care solutions at assisted living or nursing home facilities.

A 2023 STUDY


showed that caregiver stress can lead to multiple negative outcomes including worsening physical and mental health, significant financial challenges, and an overall decline in quality of life.

MULTIPLE REPORTS

in the New York Times and other media outlets have drawn attention to the nationwide crisis in long-term care solutions for an aging population with increasingly complex cognitive and physical challenges.

THE BOTTOM LINE

is adult caregivers need time away from caregiving to work and live their own lives. Moreover, with the emotional, physical, and financial demands of caregiving, they need support in maintaining their health and well-being. River House not only serves the needs of our participants, but provides essential relief to caregivers and families.

CAPABILITIES

River House was founded to provide accessible adult day care that works for all families. We ensure the highest level of care for aging adults as **the only accredited medical model facility in Greenwich, Stamford, and the surrounding area**. River House enriches every participant's daily life through specialized therapeutic recreation, a variety of daily programming, and essential socialization opportunities. Our expert care is flexible and personalized for each participant, whether they need support with personal hygiene or require more attention due to conditions like Alzheimer's and other related dementias, vision and hearing loss, arthritis, diabetes, stroke, or chronic diseases. To further support caregivers, transportation is available for all eligible participants in Greenwich and Stamford.

We value our partnerships with caregivers and offer the following services to help ease their stress:

\bigcirc	Provide a respite for caregivers, along with family consultations.	\odot	Evaluations of both participants and the family needs.
\bigcirc	Individualized plan of care, based on family input and health needs.	⊘	Administration of physician- prescribed medications and treatments.
\bigcirc	Coordinated care with personal physicians.	⊙	Assistance with personal care, hygiene, and bathing.
\bigcirc	Home and personal safety information and referrals.	⊘	Assistance with advanced care planning and implementation.

Measuring Outcomes


Our staff regularly assesses program outcomes by analyzing health improvements, social engagement, and overall satisfaction. We use this information to continuously refine our services.






Subsidized Affordability


Equitable outcomes require affordability. Therefore we offer sliding-scale fees or financial assistance for those with limited resources. No one is excluded due to financial constraints.

Make the Difference



We strive for excellence

As an accredited medical model 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, we depend on the generosity of family, friends, and community partners to ensure that the River House does not have to compromise the high quality of care that our participants deserve, require, and expect.

River House costs a participant \$120 per day, making it the most affordable and convenient care option for adults who wish to age in place in Greenwich, Stamford, and the lower Fairfield and Westchester Counties.

Home Health Aides or Companion Services cost on average \$350 or more per day, while a nursing home costs over \$475 per day. However, River House's actual cost to provide care is over \$160 per day.

Funding from the community is essential to bridge the gap between the actual cost of services verses the charge to participants. This allows us to maintain our exceptional level of care for each participant, and no one is ever turned away for an inability to afford our services. Only with your help are we able to achieve this.
